

Adventure Unlimited Dryland Race

Buena Vista, Colorado

November 15-16, 2008

Sponsored by the COLORADO MOUNTAIN MUSHERS (CMM)

SCHEDULE: Drivers packets distributed Sat 7-8 am at the race site. *Mandatory* Driver Meeting @ 8:30AM, Race Starts @ 9:00AM, class race order TBD.

RACE LOCATION: Adventure Unlimited Ranches 18325 County Road 366, Buena Vista, CO
Go north of Buena Vista on Highway 24 to County Road 384 (about 2.8 miles north of the stop light in Buena Vista). Turn LEFT on CR 384 and head west about 1.3 miles to CR 361. Turn RIGHT on CR 361 and go about 0.3 miles to the AU Ranch entrance on the LEFT. Follow signs along the main ranch road.

TRAIL: Trails may include maintained dirt roads and winding dirt ranch roads (some rocks, roots, etc. may be present). Distances and trails may vary depending on weather and trail conditions. Elevation varies from 8600 to 9000 feet, but the terrain is relatively flat. Wildlife and fenced ranch livestock may be present.

AWARDS: Ribbons & bragging rights

DRYLAND RULES: General CMM racing rules will be followed. Bibs MUST be worn. Whips are NOT allowed. Helmets for wheeled classes are strongly recommended. This is NOT an ISDRA-sanctioned event. *Please note: Adventure Unlimited is a tobacco and alcohol free private ranch. Use of tobacco or alcohol products is not allowed on their property or in their cabins.*
